Day 1: 10th December 2024

This session was conducted by the HOD, where the students got the briefing about the subjects they were going to learn and the additional knowledge they should acquire in order to compete with the industrial requirements. Along with the course structure they also came to know about Rules and regulations of the department.

Orientation on UPSC Examination Post-lunch, a session was conducted by "Insight" on opportunities and preparation strategies for the UPSC examination.

Students were divided into diverse teams to ensure interaction across various groups.
