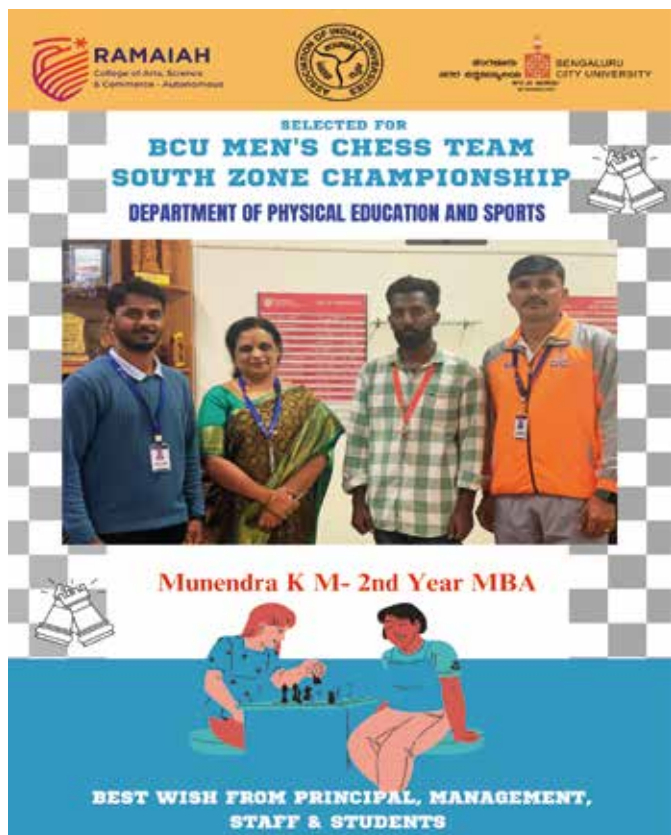

## Mastering Financial Health: A Talk on Stock Market and Derivatives



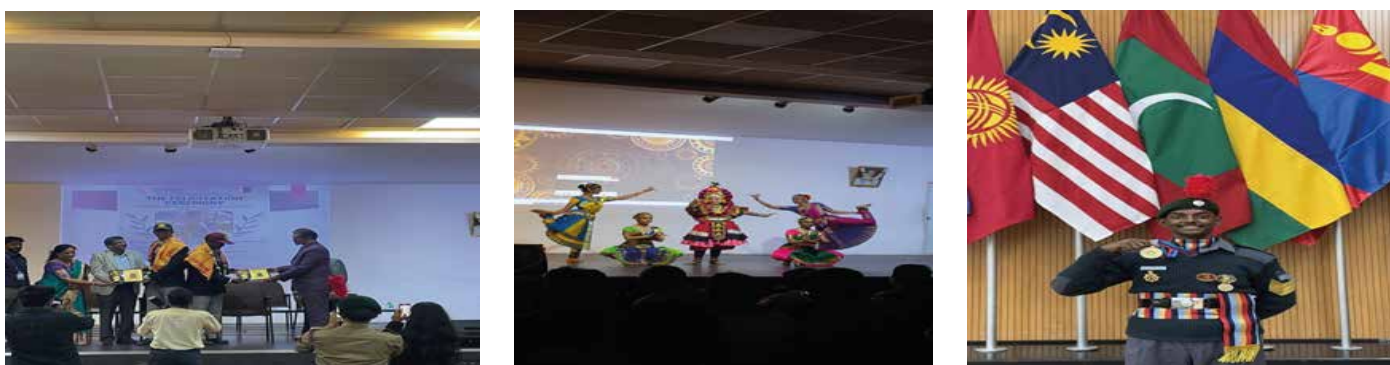
