






Q3. The course integrates theoretical course concepts with real-world applications


Q4. The assignments and internal evaluation covered the materials presented in the course



STUDENT STRONGLY AGREE ON COURSE - 2016-17


Feedback on course has been collected from 958 students across different program during academic year 2016-17



Observation:

The feedback has highlighted that, 90% of students says that the assignments and exams covered the materials presented in the course, and 10% students felt the assignments are connecting to the syllabus. 91% students said that the syllabus clearly states course objectives, requirements, procedures and grading criteria however 9% students says grading criteria and the procedures are not clear.84% responses accepted that the course material is up to date, where as 16% responses expressed that the course materials is not upto date, and not relevant for industry requirements.

Feedback on teacher has been collected from 958 students across different programs during the year. The summary analysis is presented below




Observation:

Out of 1135 responses 958 responses were found to be correct for analysis. From the graph, it is clearly perceived that teacher's efficiency in teaching and managing course content is highly acceptble. Most of the teacher's performance is up to the standard expectations of students and rated well in the feedback. Analysis has been done for each teacher individually and the department collectively.

Employer Strongly agree on curriculum 2016-17

Aggregate feedback analysis of employer feedback collected from 31 employers has been presented for the academic year




Observation:

91% employers are happy that the overall performance of the employee is good and fair. They are reliable and honest towards the work assigned to them. 80% of responses says that the course contents have a good balance between theory and practicals. But 20% employers are of the opinion that courses should include industry expectations in the syllabus, to make students fit for the job. 78% responses says that the prescribed syllabus is research oriented, however 22% feel that research should be the integral part of the course itself.

Teachers Strongly agree on curriculum for the academic year - 2016-17

Feedback on curriculum was collected from 82 teachers for the academic year 2016-17. The analysis is presented with the responses who strongly agree on different parameters of curriculum aspects.




Observation:

90% teachers feel the syllabus is updated from time to time, but in certain courses still updated syllabus has to be implemented. 84% teachers feel the BOS is taking care of relevancy of programs and courses being offered. Only 78% teachers expressed that the enough freedom is given at the university to contribute their ideas towards updating course curriculum.

Alumni Strongly agree on curriculum for the academic year - 2016-17

Alumni feedback on curriculum is gathered from 429 alumni of different batches, a summary of their response who have strongly agreed on curricular aspects for the academic year 2016-17 is presented.




Observation:

92% responses strongly agree that the learning environment in the institution is excellent. 86% responses says that the course content is relevant and updated, but 14% feel the syllabus has to be updated especially for lab and practicals. More than 79% feel the syllabus creates an interest to pursue higher studies/ research, however 21% feel that the syllabus should include more avenues for research and higher studies.

Parents Strongly agree about the institution - 2016-17


Feedback from Parents about the institution has been collected from 523 parents during the year 2016-17, and its analysis is presented below



Observation:

95% parents expressed that the academic discipline is maintained in the institution is excellent. 90% feel the students counselling and guidance is taken at most carefully. 83% expressed that the canteen facility is good but can be extended for longer hours for the benefit of students coming from distance place. 91% expressed that the work culture is satisfactory and lab facility and infrastructure is excellent.

Observation:

Student response has been collected and analyzed using excel spread sheet. Student feedback on faculty has been complied department wise and the response is shown on the graph. All the departments have shown average satisfaction in the performance of the Science, Commerce, Management, Humanities, Languages and English with more than 85% responses.
