## Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2020-21



#### Analysis report






- The most important key question is Internal assessment test and assignments, where 85% of the students agreed about the fairness.

#### Fairness of the Internal Evaluation process by the Teacher. 1,874 responses


## Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

The Teachers identify your strength and encourage you with providing right Your Mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you level of challenges.






- 72% of students reviewed that the teachers informed about the course outcomes and programme outcomes.








- Regarding Internship and field visits 60% students agreed with positive feedback.






- Almost 75% of students agreed that the teachers were able to identify their weakness and helped them to overcome it.





70 % of students agreed with the Teaching-Learning process of the Institution and the overall quality of the institute is very good.

### Observations;

- 1. A high percentage (90%) of student's complete satisfaction over the quality of the Syllabus covered and the preparedness of the teacher of the of the Institution.
