Hindi Language comes under the ambit of modern Indo-Aryan languages. The older version of Hindi was called as Hindustani, Hindavi and khadi-boli which were spoken in the 10th century B.C. The father of the nation Mahatma Gandhi was the first to recommend Hindi as a National Language during the Hindi Sahitya Sammelan.

14th September is the birth date of Beor Rajendra Sinha, a notable Hindi writer born on 1900. Mr. Simha played a crucial role in crusading for the adoption of Hindi as an official language.

Hindi Diwas or National Hindi Day is celebrated every year in the month of September on 14 to mark the adaption of Hindi (written in Devanagari script) as the official language. It was decided by the Constituent Assenbly on September 14, 1949. The First Prime minister of the country, Jawaharlal Nehru, decided to celebrate Hindi Diwas on same day.

Around 250 million people are speaking Hindi across the world. And also it is knowing that the Hindi is the fourth most spoken language in the world.

World Hindi day was first celebrated in 2006 by former Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh with an aim to promote Hindi language across the world.
