market but also in the International market. The session introduced our students about the industry, major products of the company, manufacturing of sandal wood oil, sandal soaps etc.

The orientation was concluded with an vote thanks by our students. The surroundings of the factory was planted with sandal wood trees and further, they explained about the significance of sandal wood trees. Later, we moved on to the manufacturing area where students were divided into groups and taken for the visit. The manufacturing and the processing of the sandal soaps was noticed and they also explained about the same. From manufacturing to the packaging of the Mysore sandal soaps, machineries used and the processing technology was noticed during the visit. Apart from these, significance of essential oil of sandal wood was also explained by the official. Thereby, the visit was completed by the visit to factory. Finally, after the completion of the visit students were dropped at college by 5.30.
