Resource Person: Mrs. Linda Ann John (ASTD Certified Trainer and Coach)



The interactive session with the HR manager and plant manager, provided a platform for the students to ask questions and get insights into the challenges and opportunities in the FMCG industry.


The student's visit to the packaging and dispatch section provided insights into the various packaging methods and techniques used by ITC to ensure product safety and freshness.
