EXAMINATION SECTION

1. Pattern of Examination

- ❖ The End Semester Examinations shall be held as per schedule and the same should be displayed on the college notice board at least 15 days before the commencement of the Examination by the Office of the Controller of Examination.
- ❖ The odd Semester (I/III/V) Examination shall be held in the month of November/ December and the Even Semester (II / IV/VI) Examinations in the month of April/ May.
- ❖ The office of COE shall be responsible for issue of application & hall ticket to the students.
- ❖ After the publication of the result of each End Semester Examinations, the examinees will be provided with a transcript reflecting their marks / grade obtained in each paper.
- ❖ Students should pay their prescribed examination fee through online banking and submit the fee paid receipt to office.

2. Evaluation System:

For UG CIA (Total Marks: **20**) : **No passing minimum** for CIA

Three components: Tests, Assignments and activities

- Assignments : 05 Marks (Two assignments)
- CIA Test : 10 Marks
- Activities : 05 Marks

For **PG** CIA (Total Marks: **30**): **No passing minimum** for CIA

Four components: Tests, Assignments and activities

- Assignments : 05 Marks (Two assignments)
 - CIA Test : 20 Marks
 - Seminar : 05 Marks
- ❖ If a student misses CIA / Model due to valid reasons (to be ascertained by the Head of the Department on the basis of documental proof provided by the student), the concerned HOD may arrange a special examination for such student. However, only one such special examination shall be held for all such cases and it should be conducted at least two weeks ahead of the Semester End examinations. The HODs shall be required to inform the Examination Cell before conducting such tests.

Semester End Examination:

- ❖ For UG Passing Minimum: 40% (40% S.E + C.I.A) (**Total Marks 80**)
 - ❖ For PG Passing Minimum: 50% (50% S.E + C.I.A) (**Total Marks 70**)
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3. Applicability of the Grading System

These guidelines shall apply to all undergraduate and postgraduate degree programmes under the credit system awarded by the affiliated University.

Award of Grades

The absolute grading system is adopted as follows:

Semester grade Point Average (SGPA) calculation can be done using the formula

$$SGPA_k = \frac{\sum(C_i \times G_i)}{\sum C_i}$$

Grade Point Average (GPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)

The Grade Point Average (GPA) for each semester and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) up to any semester is calculated as follows:

i) Cumulative Grade Point Average will be computed as follows:

$$CGPA = \frac{\sum_{j=1}^m GPA_j \times TC_j}{\sum_{j=1}^m TC_j}$$

Where, 'm' is the number of semesters under consideration. TC_j the total number of credits for a jth semester and GPA_j is the Grade Point Average of the jth semester.

Both GPA and CGPA will be rounded off to the second digit after decimal and recorded as such. While computing the GPA / CGPA, the subjects in which the student is awarded zero grade points will also be included.

For any academic/employment purpose the following formulae shall be used for conversion of CGPA to Percentage of marks.

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$$\text{Percentage of marks \%} = (\text{CGPA} - 0.5) \times 10$$

Requirement for clearing any subject:

- ❖ The students have to obtain a minimum of 35% in End Semester Examination and they have to score minimum of 40% marks from Internal and external exam marks put together to clear the subject. Otherwise they will be awarded fail grade.
- ❖ “F” is considered as a fail grade indicating that the student has to reappear for the end supplementary examination in that subject and obtain a non-fail grade for clearing that subject.
- ❖ To become eligible for the award of degree the student must obtain a minimum CGPA of 5.5

Award of Class

SL. No.	Class	CGPA
01	First Class with Distinction	7.5 or more
02	First Class	First Class 6.5 or more, but less than 7.5
03	Second Class	5.5 or more, but less than 6.5
04	Pass Class	Above 4.5 & below 5.5
