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Report on the Seminar - "Brief Introduction about Autonomous"

Organized by IQAC

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell organized a seminar on- "Brief introduction about autonomous" for the faculties of MSRCASC on 24.02.2024, Saturday from 11:30 am to 12:30 am at Kuvempu Seminar Hall, MSRCASC.

No. of Participants: 88

Objective of the Program

This seminar was organized by the IQAC in order to illuminate the faculties of the institution regarding the fundamentals of autonomous status. The talk also aimed to provide participants with a clear understanding of what autonomous status means for a college or educational institution. This includes autonomy in decision-making, curriculum development, assessment methods, administrative processes, and financial management.

Overview of the Program

The program started with the Ramaiah Anthem followed by the welcome address by Prof. Vijayalaxmi Ramesh, IQAC Co-ordinator, MSRCASC. Dr. Vatsala G, Principal, MSRCASC addressed the gathering and communicated the purpose of having such a seminar with the view of college attaining autonomous status soon. This was followed by the talk by resource person. Principal also highlighted that since it is the period of transition and taking the assistance of our sister institution would be highly relevant which would also be helpful in knowing how to work with the University related matters. She hoped to have a fruitful interaction with the esteemed guest.

For enlightening about the fundamentals of autonomous, Dr. Pradipkumar Dixit, Vice Principal of MSRIT had been invited as the Guest Speaker. The guest, being the member of an institution which has been autonomous for more than a decade, has rich experience in academia and is high qualified personnel. He also heads the Department of Electrical & Electronics Engineering in MSRIT. His areas of interests are high voltage engineering, outdoor insulation, lightning protection, electromagnetic compatibility and electric power quality. He is also consultant for the DRDO since 15 years.

Dr. Pradipkumar Dixit began his speech by congratulating the Ramaiah College of Arts, Science and Commerce for obtaining the status of autonomy. He said that becoming the best is easy but sustaining to be the best calls for more efforts and responsibilities. The status of autonomy is such. The autonomy is for the academic part only wherein we have the freedom for framing the curriculum, designing the course outcomes, setting the question papers, evaluation, etc. He elaborated the working details of each of these which can be highlighted as follows:

- 1. The curriculum of the institution must be different and at least one level advanced than that of the parent university.
- 2. The question papers set for the internal assessment must be qualitative and be based on Bloom's Taxonomy.
- 3. Generating 1 question paper for the semester examinations out of the 4 question papers sent for scrutiny by the members of Board of Examination would be the best practice in framing the question paper.
- 4. The course outcomes designed must be measurable and attainable. The course outcomes should be in line with the vision and mission of the Trust, institution and the department, having the Top-to-Bottom approach.
- 5. On the contrary the attainment of the course outcomes should have a Bottom-to-Top approach.
- 6. Course objectives and Course Outcomes are one and the same.
- 7. 1 Credit refers to weekly 1-hour class.
- 8. Having attendance as a criterion in providing internal marks is not encouraged.

After the session, Prof. Vijayalaxmi Ramesh thanked the guest for enlightening on the fundamentals of autonomous status and remarked that the session was precise and informative. And that we would look upon his assistance in the coming future.

Outcomes of the Program

The outcomes of the seminar "An Introduction to Autonomous Status of College" includes the following points:

 Increased Understanding: Participants gained a clear understanding of what autonomous status entails for a college or educational institution, including the scope of decisionmaking authority and areas of autonomy.

- Awareness of Benefits: Attendees became aware of the potential benefits associated with autonomous status, such as academic freedom, flexibility in curriculum design, faster implementation of reforms, and enhanced institutional reputation.
- Knowledge of Legal and Regulatory Framework: Participants became familiar with the legal and regulatory framework governing autonomous colleges, including eligibility criteria, application procedures, compliance requirements, and periodic evaluations.
- Impact on Teaching-Learning Process: Attendees also understood how autonomous status
 can positively impact the teaching-learning process by promoting innovation,
 experimentation with new teaching methods, and customization of courses to meet
 student needs.
- Recognition of Student-Centric Approaches: Participants have recognized the importance
 of adopting student-centric approaches in autonomous colleges, such as offering
 interdisciplinary programs, providing research opportunities, and promoting holistic
 development beyond academics.
- Empowerment of Faculty: Attendees appreciated the significance of faculty empowerment in autonomous colleges, including opportunities for professional development, involvement in decision-making processes, and recognition of innovative teaching practices.
- Engagement of Stakeholders: Participants learnt strategies for effectively engaging various stakeholders, including students, faculty members, alumni, industry partners, and community members, in the governance and development of autonomous colleges.
- Understanding of Challenges and Mitigation Strategies: Attendees were equipped to
 identify potential challenges associated with transitioning to autonomous status and
 implement effective mitigation strategies to address them.
- Exploration of Future Directions: Attendees were encouraged to envision the future trajectory of their college under autonomous status and explore opportunities for collaboration, innovation, and continuous improvement.

Overall, the seminar will empower participants with the knowledge, awareness, and strategies needed to navigate the process of obtaining and leveraging autonomous status effectively for the advancement of their colleges and the enrichment of the educational experience they offer.
