Insights into industry trends and requirements.

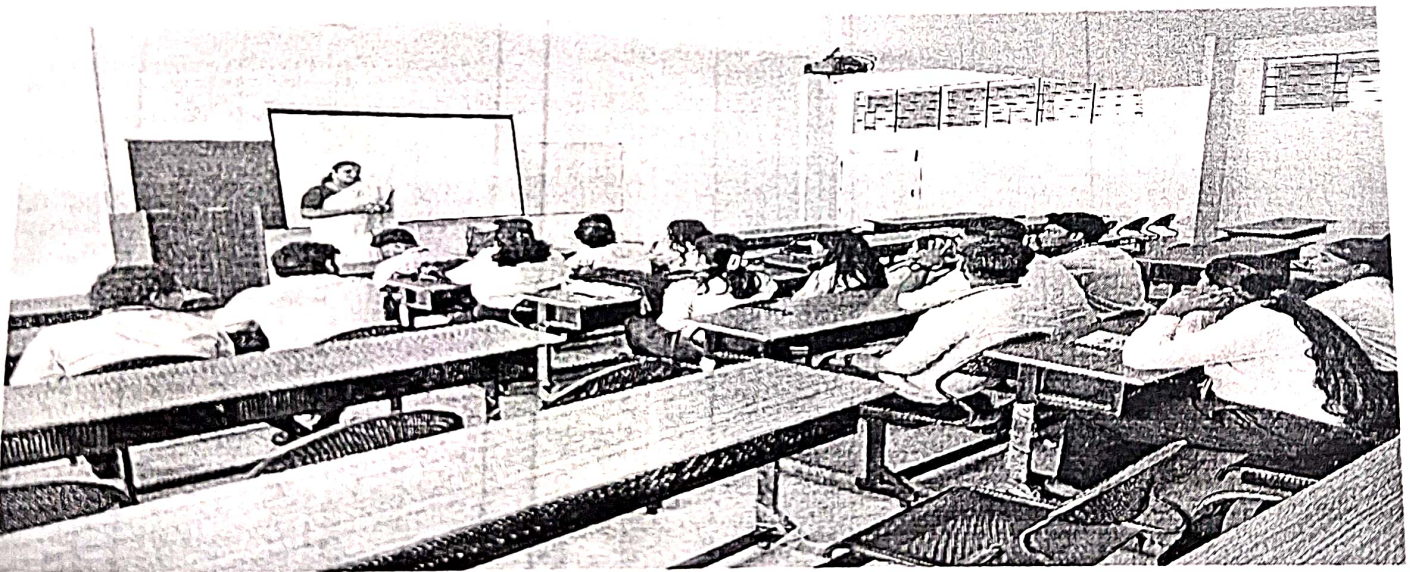
Opportunity to interact with an experienced professional and seek career-related advice.

and maximize their potential for future professional success. The Department of MBA continues to organize such events to support the holistic development of its students.

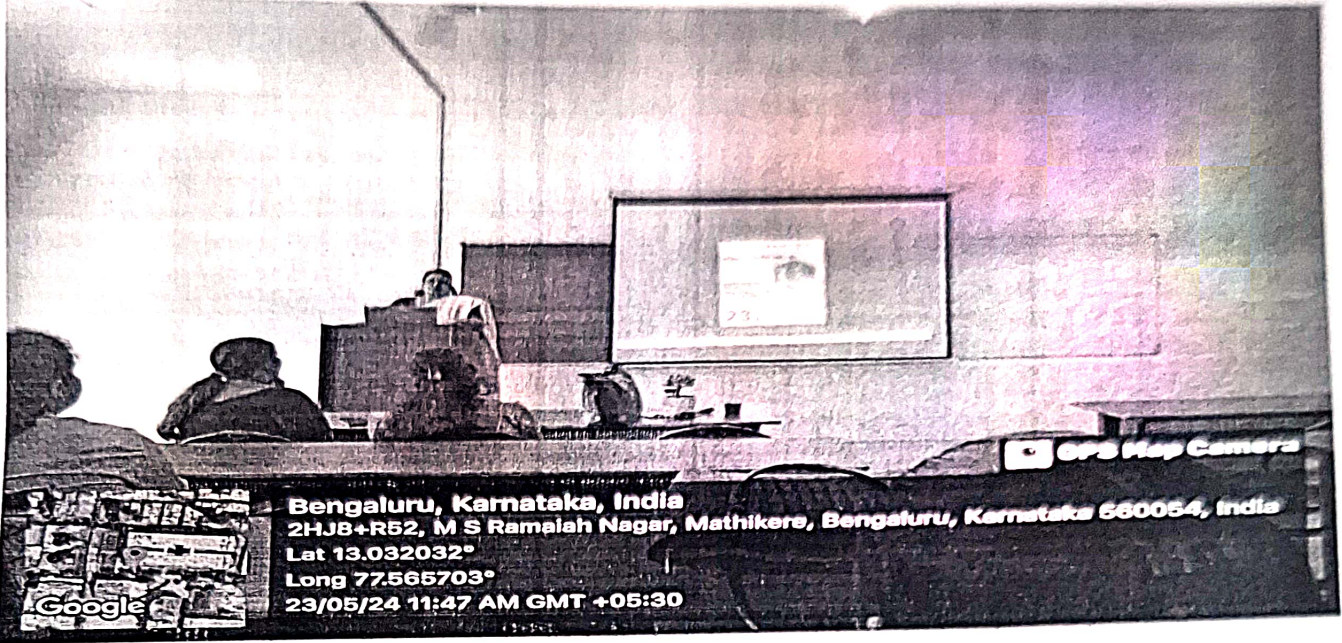

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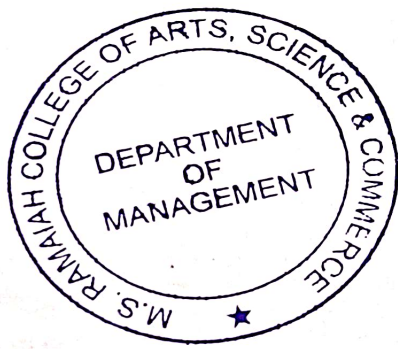
