It gives me immense pleasure to present the Annual Report for our college on the auspicious occasion of College Day 2024. This report highlights the significant achievements and milestones of our institution over the past academic year.

#### **Academic Achievements**

Our college has once again demonstrated excellence in academics. This year, 120 students graduated with distinction, and 200 students achieved first-class honors in their respective fields. We are proud to mention that our students have secured top ranks in university exams, bringing laurels to the institution. We have secured 17 university ranks (2019-2022) across various disciplines including BSc, BBA, and MSc. 23-24 UG – 3ranks and PG – 16ranks
