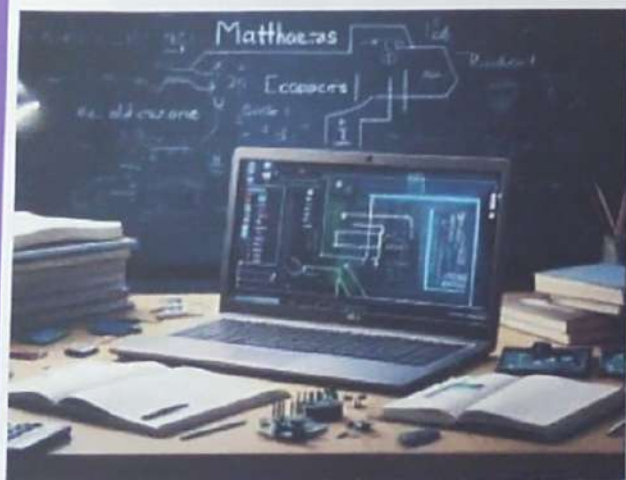

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Event Overview

The MSRCASC's BSc computer science department in collaboration with NSS held an outreach event called "E Resources" with involving Mahatma Gandhi School children in the 10th grade, Channarayana Pattana (P) and Devana Halli (T), in order to raise awareness, offer support, and inspire constructive action. College outreach initiatives are crucial for encouraging community involvement, improving students' personal growth, and making a positive impact on society. Through these activities, students can actively contribute to improving their local communities, going beyond the classroom. In a collegiate context, outreach initiatives advantageous in the following ways.

Networking: Engaging in outreach initiatives frequently entails speaking with school students, which can broaden students' professional networks and provide access to society.

Building Confidence: Students who successfully plan or take part in outreach initiatives feel more accomplished and satisfied, which in turn increases their self-confidence.

Students, along with the in-charge faculty members, began the journey from the MSRCASC campus at 9:30 AM. We reached the destination by 10:50 AM. The school staff members welcomed with the refreshment. The entire team was well prepared for e-resources that mainly contain the digital information consisting of SSLC e-books, question banks, solved papers, and smart grounding study materials for SSLC students. Computer science classes commenced at 12:00 PM.

Mrs. Asharani R., faculty of BSc Computer Science, explained the digital information, the mode of information with the LCD display, and then finally demonstrated how to access the e-resources collected by our students. QR codes for e-resources are distributed to all the 10th standard students. A quiz program was organized that consisted of a comprehension of the most exciting topic, artificial intelligence. Students were segregated into six groups; each group consists of four students. A comprehension study material was given to each group to solve the questions. Five minutes were given to solve the MCQs. Three qualified teams were awarded. Students are effectively engaging the 10th-standard students in the classroom environment.

Mrs. Shilpa N, faculty of BSc Computer Science, visited the 8th and 9th standard students and took an introductory class about computer science to bring awareness about current trends in technology. Goodies were distributed to all the students.


