The Department of Humanities (Psychology) organized two-day out reach activity event to givie training session to high students on 'enhancing memory techniques' which will be helpful for their upcoming exams.





Program Objective

- To equip psychology students with the skills to develop and effectively implement training modules.
- This hands-on experience will provide our psychology students with practical exposure in applying psychological concepts in real-world settings.
- 3. Foster a sense of social responsibility among psychology students by contributing to the academic success of school students.
- 4. To train school students in scientifically proven memory enhancement techniques to improve their academic performance.







The BA students were divided into two groups, Group 1 conducted the session for 8th-standard students. Group 2 led the session for 9th-standard students. The sessions were interactive, with school students actively participating in the exercises and discussions. BA students facilitated activities that allowed school students to apply memory techniques in real-time, making learning enjoyable and practical. The enthusiasm and curiosity displayed by the school students reflected the success of the initiative.

To encourage learning, **transparent pouches and pens were distributed** to all high school students. This small gesture aimed to support their academic journey while reinforcing the importance of organized study habits.

The outreach program was a valuable learning experience for both BA students and school students. BA students gained hands-on teaching experience, while school students acquired essential skills to improve their memory and learning efficiency. The activity successfully



bridged classroom learning with real-world application, reinforcing our commitment to using psychology for educational and social impact.
