Report on Field Visit to Missionaries of Charity Home for the Sick and Dying Destitute



The field visit began at 9:30 at the organisation. The students were told about the women who are patients at the facility. They suffer from either a mental health disorder or a physical disability. The women had been abandoned by their family and had nobody to look after them until they were brought to the organisation.

The students interacted with the patients to learn about their mental illness. The patients were interactive and told the students about themselves. The facility conducts Animal Assisted Therapy. Animal-assisted therapy (AAT) is an alternative or complementary type of therapy that includes the use of animals in a treatment. The goal of this animal-assisted intervention is to improve a patient's social, emotional, or cognitive functioning.

Objective of the Field Visit:

- Apply Theoretical Knowledge in Real Settings: To observe how psychological concepts and theories are practically implemented in professional environments.
- . Understand the Roles of Mental Health Professionals: To gain insight into the duties and responsibilities of psychologists, counsellors, and other practitioners.
- Develop Observation and Communication Skills: To improve critical skills such as active listening, empathy, and behavioural observation through real-life interactions.
- Learn Ethical and Professional Practices: To understand the ethical guidelines, confidentiality standards, and professional conduct required in psychological work.
