4	National Overseas Scholarship Scheme (NOS) for ST candidates	The National Overseas Scholarship (NOS) for ST candidates supports postgraduate, Ph.D., and post-doctoral studies abroad. Run by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, it provides financial aid to economically weaker students (family income ≤ ₹8 lakh/year). Applicants must have secured admission to a foreign university and meet academic criteria. Key documents include ST certificate, admission letter, income proof, academic marksheets, and a passport-size photo. Applications are submitted online via the NOS portal integrated with Digi Locker.	
5	HDFC Bank Parivartan's ECSS Programme for Undergraduate Students	The HDFC Parivartan ECSS Programme offers a meaningful support path for UG students in India who are both meritorious and financially strained—especially those grappling with recent family or personal crises. Through a structured online process on Buddy4Study, successful applicants can gain financial relief tailored to their field of study. Photograph, last marksheet, identity proof (Aadhaar/Voter ID/Driving License), current admission proof (fee receipt/admission letter/ID), bank details (passbook/cheque), income proof (SDM/Tehsildar certificate, Gram Panchayat affidavit, etc.), proof of crisis (if any)	https://www.hdfcbankecss.com/
6	AMP Higher Education Scholarship – 2025	Muslim students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds who are Zakat-eligible under Sharia guidelines. Must have completed Class 12 , or be currently enrolled in Diploma/UG/PG programs. Fields prioritized include Medical , Engineering , Law , Journalism , and vocational diplomas at NCVT-affiliated institutes.
