In the context of recent initiatives by the NAAC which seeks to promote indigenous knowledge through Higher Educational Institutions by mandating it as a point in one of its criteria, MSRCASC has established an Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) Cell to catalyse research, education and various activities centred around Indian Knowledge Systems.

India's rich heritage offers a vast repository of traditional knowledge across sciences, humanities, commerce and management. Establishing an IKS Cell will empower the institution to engage in original research, curriculum integration and dissemination of this heritage, developing inter-disciplinary scholarships and innovation.

The IKS Cell at MSRCASC was formally inaugurated on 28th October 2025 by the Chief Guest His Grace Sri Rama Sevaka Prabhu from ISKCON Bangalore; Principal Dr. Pushpa H and Vice-Principal Prof. B S Jayaram. An inauguration souvenir of the IKS Cell was released on the occasion.

Following which, an orientation on "Mind Management and Spiritual Quotient" to the 1st year UG students for two days was organised in association with ISKCON, Bangalore.

Day 1 commenced with an introduction speech by Nisha and Janavi (BCA), followed by the Ramaiah Anthem. The soulful invocation song by Pannaga (BSc) set a serene tone for the session. The Principal, Dr. Pushpa H, delivered the inaugural address, after which the Mr. Mayur (Dept. of Sanskrit)
